## NOTICE OF PROJECT PLANNING PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Harbor Beach will hold a public meeting on the proposed Water System Improvements Project for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons.

The meeting will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at Harbor Beach's City Hall.

The purpose of the proposed project is improvements to the City's water system.

Changes to the water system will include replacement of approximately 1,800 linear feet of watermain and approximately 6,000 linear feet of water transmission main plus 6,000 linear feet of redundant transmission main, 450 linear feet of new watermain on State Street to create system looping, replacement of approximately 30 service lines suspected to contain lead components, upgrades to the Water Treatment Plant, and the addition of a tank mixer to the elevated water storage tank.

Impacts of the proposed project include minor traffic operation, increased local noise and dusts levels typically of a construction project. There are no anticipated long-term impacts from this project.

The estimated project costs will be discussed at the public meeting. User rates will be adjusted to service the debt and operate and maintain the proposed improvements over time. The estimated cost increase to users for the proposed project will be discussed at the public meeting and the final costs will be dependent on the terms of the financing proposed by EGLE for this project.
